



Child Volunteer Recruitment Policy

Carrick Town AFC existence depends on the voluntary effort of all its volunteers.

Volunteers are the driving force of the club and without them the club would not be able to offer football opportunities in our community.

It is important that the club provides a healthy environment for volunteers and recruits the right people.

The following recruitment steps will help to protect young people and assist in placing volunteers in a position to which they are suited and supported.

1. Role Descriptions – The club will provide a role description for all new volunteer positions that will include duties and responsibilities.
2. Interview – The applicants will meet with at least two members of the committee.
3. Garda Vetting – In line with legislation and the FAI's child welfare policy everyone working with children or vulnerable adults will require Garda vetting before starting role.
4. Induction – Every new volunteer will be provided support where required and made aware of the club policies and procedures.
6. Training – Where possible the club will provide training to upskill volunteers.
7. Volunteers – All volunteers will adhere to the clubs and the FAI's rules and code of conducts.
